Acts 2:16-17

Hebrews 1:1-2 (see Isaiah 2:2) → inaugurates a "New Covenant" or a new "administration" (Jeremiah 31) → same heart of God, same sinfulness of man, same new birth, same response of repentance

What's new is JESUS: 1) victory over the sin and death means the curse is beginning to reverse

2) victory over Satan means the gospel is free \rightarrow Revelation 20:1-3
